ROLE OF THE CESTAT

CREATION OF TRIBUNALS - INTENTION

- Speech, cost effective and accessible justice
- Openness, fairness, impartiality, expertise, user friendly and few Government prejudices

ROLES OF AAR, SETTLEMENT COMMISSION & CESTAT

1- AAR

Proactive

- More discretion in the absence of an underlying case
- More autonomy and closer to judicial power rather then quasi-judicial power

ROLES OF AAR, SETTLEMENT COMMISSION & CESTAT

2 - Settlement Commission

- More in the nature of summary proceedings
- More in the nature of arbitration than adjudication
- Decision should be made on the strength of bona-fide disclosure rather than through the process of assessment

ROLES OF AAR, SETTLEMENT COMMISSION & CESTAT

3 - CESTAT

- Exercise of judicial power with the trappings of quasi-judicial functions
- It is adjudication and not conciliation or arbitration
- Role of regulatory Tribunals vs. CESTAT
- Role is supplemental and not a substitute
- Qualities and qualifications akin to judges
