
### **District courts**

As per phase II document, **122** services are provided through various service delivery channels achieving 100% compliance


Remaining **56** services were to be provided by the respective high courts as these services fall under periphery e.g. status of certified copy, online payments etc.

### **eCourts Services Portal**

- ✓ e-Courts portal (http://ecourts.gov.in) is a one-stop solution for all stakeholders such as litigants, advocates, government agencies, police and common citizens.
- ✓ Portal is a centralized gateway and provides links to several initiative and services provided under eCourts project
- ✓ services.ecourts.gov.in for district courts and hcservices.ecourts.gov.in for high courts.
  - Provides case information to citizens from all courts in the country.
  - Case status/cause lists/orders/judgments are available on the site.
- ✓ Works in bilingual mode.
- ✓ Information in local language is provided for those states which are using CIS in bilingual mode.
- ✓ GIGW compliant and accessible.


# **District Courts of India - services.ecourts.gov.in**

- 170 M case data of cases is available (pending + disposed)








# **District Courts of India - districts.ecourts.gov.in**


# **High Courts of India - ecourts.gov.in/ecourts\_home/static/highcourts**

- Every high court has separate domain.



### **Current Status**

- Data from across 24 high courts online.
- Total 3,89,47,828 cases (pending and disposed) and 6,62,82,97 orders and judgments are available.



# **eCourts Services - Mobile App**

- Common app for district courts and high courts.
- Available on android and iOS.
- Facility to search and track case using QR code.
- Portfolio of interested cases can be created for automatically tracking the future status. Useful for institutions and advocates having multiple cases.
- Calendar feature to view occupancy at a glance
- Import/export facility available to take backup of portfolio cases and save it on local storage or google drive.

### **Current Status**



- More than 50 Lakh android users have downloaded the mobile app from google playstore.
- Average rating on google play store is 3.7 acquired from 48 k ratings.
- 2,50,000 installs on iOS.



# **SMS Facility - SMS Push & Pull**


### **SMS Push**

SMS on occurrence of event in a case like filing, registration, adjournment, scrutiny, listing, transfer of case, disposal, uploading of order etc. is sent on mobile registered with the court.



### **SMS Pull**

SMS pull facility can be used by a stakeholder to send 16 character CNR number of a case to 97668-99899, and get its current status.



### **Current Status**

Around 3 lakh SMS are sent daily




# **Automated e-Mails - Email sent to Litigants, Advocates and Police Stations**

- E-Mails are automatically sent to Litigants, advocates and police stations.
- Daily cause lists (pertaining to their cases), events like next dates, transfer of case, disposal etc is sent.
- Copy of order, copy of judgment etc., in .pdf format is also mailed. This is useful specially in family court cases where judgment/order is not publicly available on the portal and delivered in the email account of the litigant.



### **Current Status**

More than 3.5 lakhs emails are sent daily



# **Touch Screen Kiosks and Service Centre**

- Touch screen kiosks are installed at various court complexes across the country.
- Litigants and advocates can view case status, cause lists etc., on kiosk.
- Same information can also be obtained from Judicial Service Centre established at each court complex



# ePayments - pay.ecourts.gov.in


- Online payment of court fee, fine, penalty and judicial deposits has been initiated online through pay.ecourts.gov.in.
- ePayment portal is also integrated with state specific vendors like SBI ePay, GRAS, eGRAS, JeGRAS, Himkosh, Rajkosh etc.

The e-Filing system is a complete end to end solution developed for online filing of cases. Both Civil and Criminal cases can be filed before any High Court and District Court of the country wherever the e-Filing system is adopted.



- ✓ Entire filing can be done in asynchronous mode without Advocate and clients meeting each other
- ✓ Submission of pleadings in the courts, video recording of Oath, when Client, Advocate and Court are geographically situated at different locations is now possible






# Tool for management authorities - NJDG Intra

# **National Service and Tracking of Electronic Processes (NSTEP)**

- Centralized process service tracking application and a mobile app for bailiffs.
- Mobile app available in bilingual mode
- NSTEP is used for speedy delivery of processes and reducing inordinate delays in process serving.
- Speedy transmission of processes and service status within state (intra-state)
  and outside state (inter-state).
- NSTEP mobile app, provided to bailiff, helps in real time and transparent tracking of service.
- GPS location, photograph of addressee, photograph of door lock as proof of non service can be tracked.


# Virtual Courts – Online Adjudication - vcourts.gov.in

### **Key Features**

- Virtual Court eliminates physical presence of offender/violator in the court.
- Number of judges performing judicial work in adjudicating traffic challans across the state can be reduced virtually to single judge located in any part of the state.
- Electronic traffic challans are made available to the virtual court for adjudication.
- Virtual Judge can proceed adjudication of the cases online by imposing fine.
- On imposing the fine by virtual judge, violator gets the SMS on his/her mobile to visit portal vcourts.gov.in and may pay the fine amount.
- On successful payment of the fine, the case is deemed disposed off.
- If violator, wish to contest the case, response is recorded by entering OTP on the portal. In such eventuality the case is transferred to regular court for further hearing.

# Integration with other systems

### **MCA Portal**

 CIS is integrated with MCA portal for fetching company related information specially email address for service of summons electronically. Implemented as pilot in Commercial Courts of Bombay, Delhi, Karnataka, and Calcutta.

## **Land Records**

 CIS is integrated with Land Records data in Maharashtra, Haryana, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh. Data pertaining to record of rights is now available with CIS and information related to case for particular survey number is shared with Land Records department through APIs



#### **Common Service Centres**

- Common Service Centers (CSCs) are access points for delivering services to citizens from rural and remote parts of the country.
- e-Courts APIs are shared with CSCs.
- Citizens can get the status of their cases through these centres.
- Those who are not connected on internet platform or mobile app can get the services through nearest CSC.

### **LIMBS**


- LIMBS mechanism is developed by Department of Legal Affairs Government of India to provide status of litigation to central government institutions.
- eCourts APIs are shared with LIMBS

# Integration with Interoperable Criminal Justice System (ICJS)

0

- Inter-operable Criminal Justice System (ICJS) aims at integrating
  - Crime and Criminals Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS)
  - e-Courts
  - e-Prisons databases
- CCTNS shares FIR and Charge Sheet data in electronic form to eCourts application.
- Names of the accused, details of offence, time, date, place of occurrence, details of arrest, actssections etc. is shared.
- Minimizes data entry on courts side.
- eCourts shares CNR number to the CCTNS through ICJS. Further updates about the case are made available through APIs.



## **SMS Alerts**

- SMS alerts are provided to Judges when cases remain undated in the court.
- More alerts can be provided.

## **JustIS Mobile App**

- JustIS Mobile App, provided to judicial officers, helps them to monitor pendency and disposal at finger tips.
- Many reports are available in graphical and grid form.
- Facility to tag important cases and mark short note for such case is available. These cases are specially marked when listed. Judge can identify the cases of important nature on the cause list.

## **Open APIs**




- Open APIs are developed and are being published for district courts.
- These APIs may be used by institutional litigants (like government departments) to further develop their own monitoring and compliance mechanism/ software to track and manage their cases.
- This helps major stakeholders to proactively take actions on the courts directions and comply accordingly.
- APIs can be used for particular state or for entire country.
- Accordingly, user may have to apply in prescribed format to e-Committee (if data from entire country is required)
  or respective high court (if data from specific state is required).
- eCommittee or respective state can authorize the user for further use by providing authentication credentials.

#### **Current Status**

APIs are published on Bharat API and are used by 19 Central users and 55 State users



## Judgment Search


- New portal for searching high court Judgments.
- Facility to search judgments on various parameters like Case Type, Act, judge, decision date etc. including combination of five free text search criteria
- The system is integrated with high court NJDG and can leverage all the benefits of NJDG.
- Developed using Elastic Search technology.
